Members of Shir Tikvah and P'nai Or, their parents, spouses/partners, and children.

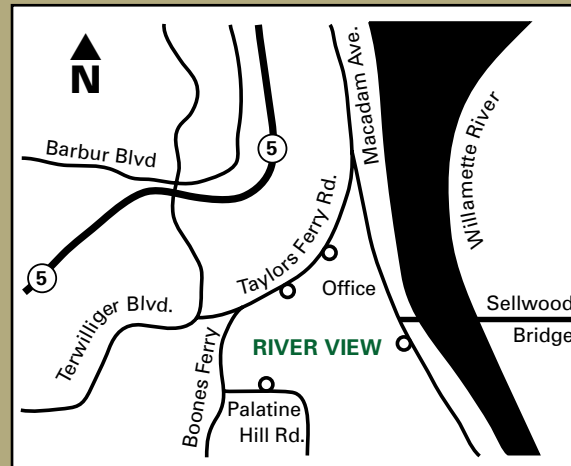
Jews unaffiliated with a synagogue but who wish to be buried in a Jewish cemetery.

Directions:

Coming 1-5 South

Follow 1-5 South to Exit 297 Terwilliger Blvd., Lewis & Clark exit. Keep in right lane. Exit off freeway, take right hand fork. Follow signs to Lewis and Clark College. At 1st light turn Right onto Terwilliger Blvd. Proceed on overpass bridge across freeway. Follow Terwilliger Blvd. until you come to Taylors Ferry Rd. (- 3rd signal light). Turn Left at Taylors Ferry Rd. Cemetery is on the right hand side, approximately 1/2 mile from your turn off Terwilliger. Take 2nd entrance into cemetery.

Coming 1-5 North

Follow 1-5 North to Exit 297 - Terwilliger Blvd., Lewis & Clark exit & Oregon Health Sciences University. (Stay in right hand lane, otherwise you'll go right back onto the freeway) Right at signal light onto Terwilliger Blvd. Follow Terwilliger to Taylors Ferry Rd. Turn Left at Taylors Ferry Rd. Cemetery is on the right hand side, approximately 1/2 mile from your turn off Terwilliger. Take 2nd entrance into cemetery.

THE JEWISH CEMETERY AT RIVER VIEW

The Jewish Cemetery at River View was created as a cooperative effort between two Portland congregations: Shir Tikvah and P'nai Or. Founded to serve all Jews, this consecrated cemetery is secluded in a corner of Portland's oldest non-profit burial ground: The River View Cemetery.

The Jewish Cemetery at River View is open to all Jews, regardless of affiliation, and allows burial of a non-Jewish spouse or partner and burial of a same-sex spouse or partner. The Cemetery also offers cremation plots and a wall of remembrance for the names of those who are buried elsewhere.

Plots can also be purchased in advance as a way to support this cemetery's contribution to the Jewish community. An advance purchase can also be a great kindness to your loved ones.

Established in 1882, the non-profit River View Cemetery, offers views of downtown Portland, Mt. Hood and Mt. St. Helens. The grounds are a virtual arboretum providing shelter to deer, coyote and hawk. A haven for bird watchers with over 80 species, this bucolic setting blooms year-round with rhododendron, dogwood, Rose of Sharon, and the prized spring trillium. Evergreen and deciduous trees include the copper beech, redwood, and magnolia, as well as many mature Douglas firs.

To ensure longevity of the cemetery, its early creators established a non-profit endowment fund overseen today by the volunteer Board of Trustees. This ensures on-going service, maintenance and expansion for future generations.
