Join Rabbi Ariel for a three-part workshop to help prepare you to host your own Seder, answer your own questions, and teach your children about Pesakh.

All sessions will take place during Nashira Project Sunday class sessions from 10am until 11.30am. We'll explore traditional and modern texts from Talmud and Midrash to the latest educational parent guides.

February 26: Workshop I

Spiritual and practical preparation for Pesakh: the religious calendar's count down, holy day *tzedakah*, gathering and selling your *hametz*, the ritual of *bedikat hametz*.

March 4: Workshop II

The Seder: the Seder plate, the Haggadah, and the Four Cups. Keeping young children from going nuts.

March 11: Workshop III

The theological aspects: ten plagues, Pharoah's hardened heart, jumping into the deep water with Nakhshon ben Amminadav.
